

When we know it, believe it, speak it, and act on it where it requires action, **this FAITH will produce the intended results.**

God has spoken it to us and as we believe and speak it, **it comes to pass.**

Heb 11:1 Now **FAITH** is the **substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.**

Heb 11:1 **FAITH** is the **assurance, confirmation and title deeds** of things hoped for, (AMPV).

Heb 11:1 **FAITH** is the **proof of things we do not see,** (AMPV).

Heb 11:1 **FAITH perceives as real fact what is not revealed to the senses,** (AMPV).

When I have FAITH for something I HAVE IT NOW. I may not see it, feel it, hold it, smell it, **BUT I HAVE IT NOW.**

Jesus said, **“Believe you receive it and you will have it,”** *Mk 11:24*

Rom 4:17 **God calls those things that be not as though they were.** He said to Abraham, **“I have made you a father of many nations.”** At that time he did not have one child, *Gen 17:5.*

How can God do this?

Well **He sees the end from the beginning,** *Is 46:10.*

God is outside of our time/space world in the eternal present, *Ex 3:14.*

God’s Word says, **“What is to be has already been,”** *Ecc 3:15.*

Therefore when God speaks to you a Word of **FAITH Believe and declare that you have it NOW and by determined persistent FAITH it will be yours,** *Heb 6:12,15, 2Pet 1:3,4, Mat 7:7,8.*

Use your faith by speaking it, declaring it, singing it, shouting it, praying it, praising with it, thanking with it, **BELIEVING IT,** refusing fear, doubt, worry, reasoning, man’s ideas, wrong belief, *Rom 4:20, Jam 1:6, Jam 5:15, Heb 11:1, (AMPV).*

Eph 6:17 says that the “rhema” Word of **FAITH** is the sword of the Spirit. **We are to use it offensively, where appropriate,** to cut down and cast out sickness, sin, satan, demons, poverty, fear, untruth, evil influencing others we are responsible for, disease and so on.

Finally remember:

FAITH operates by **what you say and believe,** *Lk 17:6,14, Mk 11:23, 2Cor 4:13, Mat 17:20, Rom 4:17b.*

The smallest speck of FAITH will remove the biggest mountain, *Mat17:20, Mk 11:23, Lk 17:6.*

Keep a humble servant attitude. Our faithful service to God does not put Him in a place of obligation to us, *Lk 17:7-10.* It is all unmerited grace, by faith, from God, through Christ.
