

GOD IS THE SOURCE OF OUR SUPPLY – REPENT AND TURN FROM TRUSTING IN IDOLS

God is the Creator of all things. He sustains and upholds all things by the Word of His power, and supplies the needs of all who look to Him and trust Him. *Heb 1:2,3, Ps 23:1, Ps 145:16, Mat 6:26, Gen 22:14, Jer 2:13, Jer 17:7,8, Rom 8:32, 2Cor 9:8, Ps 34:10, Ps 84:11, Ac 17:25, Josh 1:8.*

God expects us to depend on Him to meet all our needs. *Lk 11:3,4.* We all need His daily provision, His mercy and His protection. *Ps 34:9,10.*

Boaz said to Ruth, **“The Lord repay your labour, and a full reward be given to you by the Lord God of Israel,** under whose wings you have come for refuge. *Ruth 2:12.*

God’s divine power has given to us all things for life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us to His glory and virtue or moral excellence. *2Pet 1:3, Phil 4:19, 3Jn 2.*

If God did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, **will He not also with Him freely give us all things.** *Rom 8:32.* [material, physical, mental, spiritual, social, work, financial, family, ministry.]
God declares that **He is the Fountain of Living Waters.** *Jer 2:13, Ps 36:8,9.*

The way we receive from God the meeting of all our needs, is by faith in the promises of His Word. Every believer in Christ is expected to **live by faith.** *Rom 1:17, Heb 10:38, Is 7:9.*

Resist the devil who tries to stop/hinder financial supply. *Jam 4:7, Mat 16:19, Mat 18:18, Col 1:13, Heb 2:14, 1Jn 3:8.*

We receive salvation and the forgiveness of all our sins, by faith in what Jesus did for us in His death on the Cross and resurrection. *Eph 2:8, Rom 4:25, Ac 16:31.*

And so it is with every need that we have. God has provided for the meeting of every need through His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ. *Phil 4:19.*

There are thousands of promises, from God to us, in His Word. *2Pet 1:4, 2Cor 1:20, Num 23:19, Heb 10:23, 2Cor 7:1.*

Because God has directed us to look to Him for our daily bread and the meeting of all our needs, *Lk 11:3,4, Phil 4:19,* **it is a snare and trap to look to man.**

A curse of poverty is pronounced upon those who trust in man. *Jer 17:5,6.*

God says, **“My people have forsaken Me, the Fountain of Living Waters.”** *Jer 2:13.* “they have hewn out for themselves broken cisterns that can hold no water.”

When we turn from God as the source of our supply, **we are setting up an idol of our own making.** *Ex 32:3,4, 1K 12:28, Hos 5:4.* God says, “Control and direct your deeds in turning to your God, for **the spirit of harlotry is in your midst,** and you do not know the Lord”. This Word is in *Hos 5:4.* This a very serious Word to the people of God in Siaya. The spirit of harlotry is setting up idols that come before the Lord. *Ex 20:4.*

God’s Word gives very strong warnings against any form of idolatry. *1Cor 6:9, 1Cor 10:19-21, Ex 20:4-6, 1Jn 5:21, 1K 14:9,15, Hos 5:4, 1K 14:22,23.*

Idolatry will prevent anyone inheriting the Kingdom of God. *1Cor 6:9,10.* You cannot go to be with the Lord if you are worshipping idols. *1Cor 10:21.*

If the TV is keeping you from seeking God’s face and serving Him it is an idol.

If you are looking to man to supply your needs, you are in idolatry. “Mzungu” is not God. Seek God in His Word and by faith, trust Him to supply all your needs. *Phil 4:19, Ps 23:1, Josh 1:8, Ps 1:1—3.* Put God in first place in all things and at all times.

Coveting and desiring another person’s money is idolatry. *Col 3:5,6, Heb 13:5, Ex 20:17, 1Tim 6:10,6.*

God is the source of our supply. Look to Him. Believe His Word and promises. Put God first. *Mat 6:33.*
