Common Grace.

Believers' Grace

When a man or woman, or boy or girl, **turn to God our Father in repentance and faith**, they become **the child of the Eternal**, **Everlasting, Provider, Creator God**. They become the inheritor of the Kingdom of God, and obtain eternal life, and access to all the riches of God's Kingdom. John 1:12, 13, John 5:24, 1John 3:1, 2, 1John 4:10, Ephesians 1:3, Ephesians 2:4, 5, 6 - 10, Philippians 4:19, Psalm 84:11, Galatians 3:14, Genesis 24:1, Acts 10:38, Psalm 127:2, Psalm 25:12 – 14, Psalm 1:1 – 3, Isaiah 53:4 – 6, 1John 1:9, 7, 1John 2:1, 2, Psalm 112:1 – 9, Matthew 11:11, Luke 22:29

Repentance is the point at which we confess all our sins to God and receive forgiveness, 1John 1:9, 7, turn from all sin, 1John 3:1 – 7, and surrender completely to the Lordship of Jesus Christ, Luke 6:46, Matthew 7:21, John 14:15, 23. Jesus said, "Unless you **repent** you will all likewise perish." Luke 13:3, Acts 2:38, Acts 20:21, Acts 26:20 **God commands all people, everywhere, to repent**. Acts 17:30

Faith is believing, in the heart, what God says to us. Romans 10:10. Jesus said, "Repent and believe the Gospel."

We get saved by repentance and faith, **and from then onwards**, <u>we live by receiving the meeting of every need</u>, <u>by faith</u>. Mark 11:24, Mark 9:23, Mark 10:27, John 11:40, Acts 2:38, Acts 3:16, Ephesians 2:8, Romans 4:5, 2Corinthians 5:7, Hebrews 6:12, Hebrews 11:6, James 1:6

Faith comes to us through <u>the Father/son, Father/daughter relationship</u> with our Heavenly Father, as we hear His voice. Romans 10:17, Matthew 4:4, Matthew 13:9, Matthew 13:16, John 14:26, 1John 2:27

Hearing our Father's voice is our birth right. John 10:27, 28. (The Indian shepherd leads, feeds, waters his sheep, constantly talking/singing to them, calling them each by name and hearing their cries of response. I have watched this process.)

<u>Our Father speaks to us through His Word</u>, by drawing our attention to a verse, and by His Spirit, in dreams, pictures, impressions, thoughts and inward witness, prophecies, the preacher preaching, teaching from God's Word, sharing, praying, an angel, or circumstances.

When our Father speaks to us, it is a help to <u>write it down in our journal</u>, with the thoughts we receive, and date it. Jeremiah 31:21

As we <u>believe</u> in our hearts the Word He has spoken to us, and <u>proclaim</u> it out aloud; <u>act</u> on it, or receive the provision; <u>our Father's life</u> and provision will flow to us in abundance.
